 - All degrees are with honors - first student to graduate with the DPE (Hons) degree from Sydney Teachers' College and the first student to graduate with a Ph.D. degree in Human Performance from Indiana University.
 - Has received accelerated promotions and awards of tenure at all institutions - was promoted from the rank of Assistant-Professor to Full-Professor bypassing the Associate-Professor level.
 - Started the first post-graduate degree in the study of Theory of Coaching in the western world.
 - Is recognized as the founding scholar in the field of *Behavioral Sport Psychology* - is recognized as a world authority in *Coaching Science*.
 - Has written 74 books and technical manuals.
 - Has published more than 450 articles, book chapters, and sport psychology tests.
 - Has been the keynote speaker at many world and international congresses and symposia - has lectured and provided workshops on most continents.
 - Is a four-time Olympic Team psychologist for Canada (for sports of wrestling, swimming, ski-jumping, and cross-country skiing).
 - Is the first sport psychologist to be appointed to a Canadian Olympic Team and to become a member of the Olympic Club of Canada.
 - Has represented Canada and the USA at Olympic Games, Commonwealth Games, World Championships, and World Cup events in a number of sports.
 - Has consulted with more than 80 international organizations in the fields of sport psychology, coaching science, coaching education, and systems design.
 - Has coached world-record holders and has been psychologist to some of the world's best athletes.
 - Was selected on the first All-American Rugby Team.
 - Is the proprietor of the international consulting firm of Sports Science Associates.
